B I B L I O G R A P H Y

All texts that are quoted or cited in this three part work are included here. The listing is arranged in alphabetical order, by author's surname. For publications that have no author, but do have the name of the translator, the translator's name is used. And for publications that have neither author nor translator, i.e. THE BOOK OF JASHER, the title will be placed according to the first significant word in the title of the publication. Other than the few books that fall into this group, titles are not generally alphabetized in this listing, excepting a few like THE MISHNAH that merit such individual attention.

There are a few other conventions to mention: for multiple citations of an author, an underline replaces repetitions of the author's name. For texts where there is a multiplicity of publishing locations, only the first is cited. In author citations where christian and middle names are represented by initials, no punctuation sets them off. In compound surnames, minor names, eg. 'de' will be overlooked when placing the surname in this list. Finally, all foreign language accents, unique letters, ligatures, etc. are omitted, here as in the text, due to the limitations of the fonts.

Perusal of this list reveals the breadth of sources gleaned for support and insight. Virtually all domains of knowledge are tasted - except for the world of math, one which has eluded me since the move from Alaska into an already advanced algebra class in Boston.

The effects of such intense and broad reading are many. On one hand, it is illuminating to discover similar concepts which reinforce those stated above. But on another, it is disturbing to discover that the LDS faith is not nearly as unique as it purports to be. For example, Emanuel Swendenborg's 18th Century works predate Joseph Smith by fifty years, yet they foreshadow his conceptions, even though he certainly didn't have access to them. Indeed, they illuminate Joseph's work with details that feel like ones he would endorse.

Where do the stunning parallels derive between the Egyptian and LDS temple rituals? How does one factor in the correspondences between the Tibetan BOOK OF THE DEAD and the LDS faith? I don't know. I hold onto my childhood faith purely on the basis of that - faith. I know less and less, the further I wander through this life and this work. The LDS faith is as good a vehicle as any other for carrying one through life, though the suspicion is growing that it is not the only suitable one.
